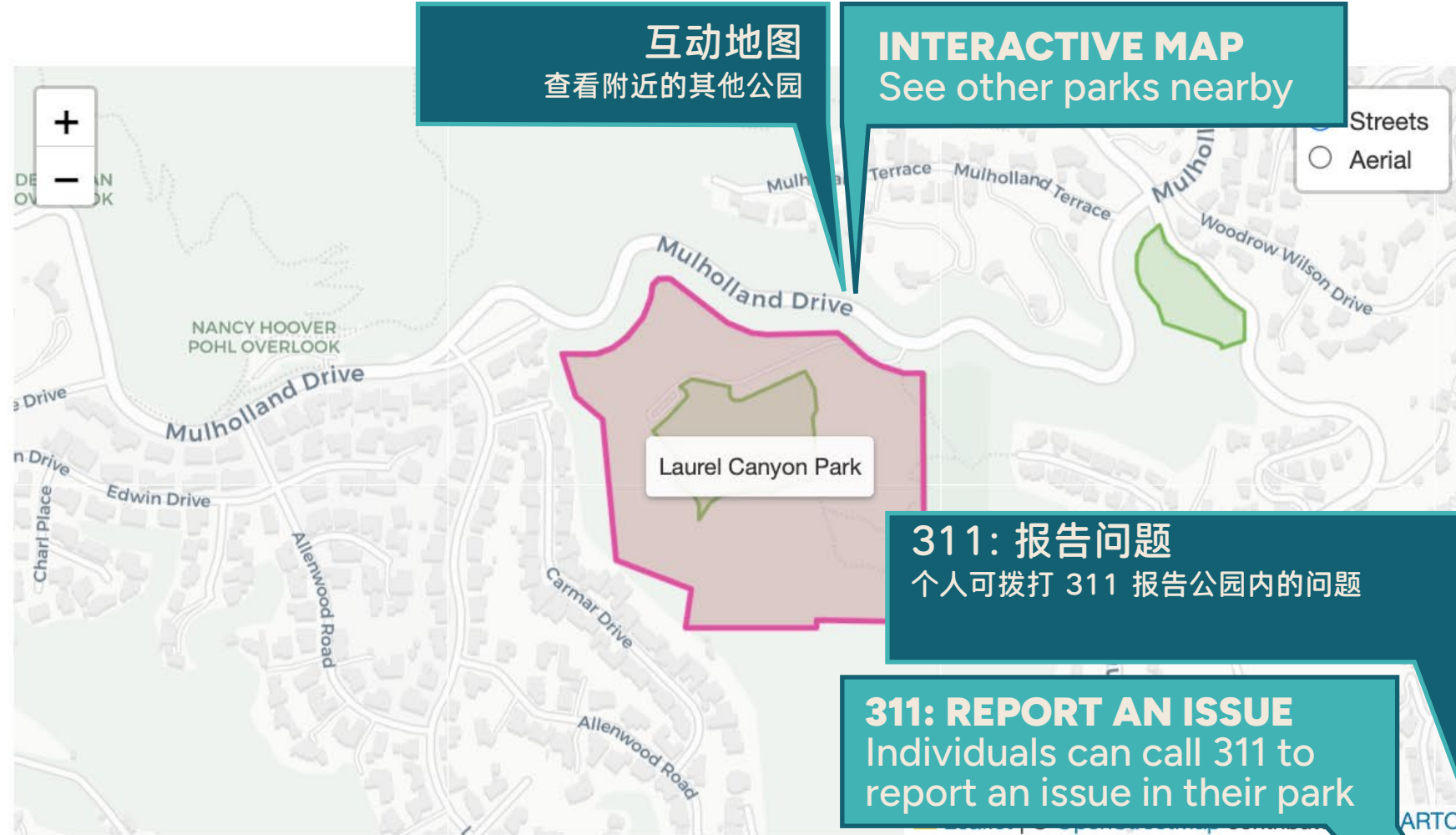

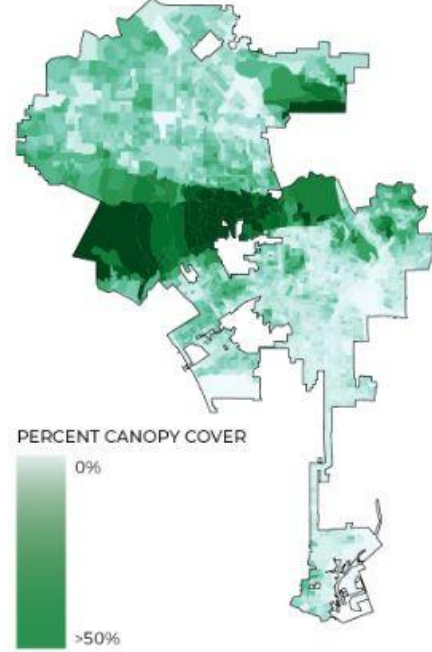

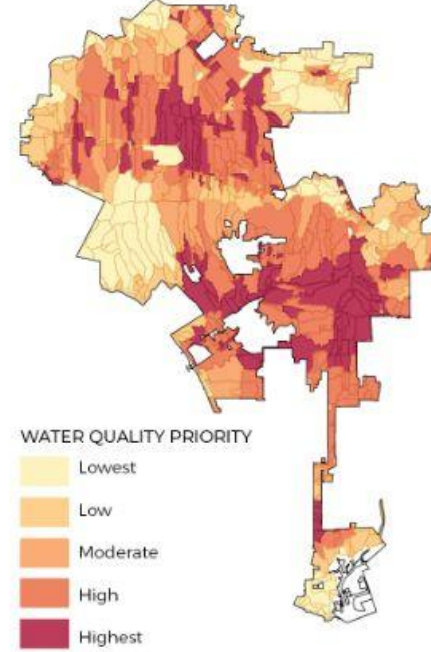

TREE CANOPY COVER BY BLOCK GROUP



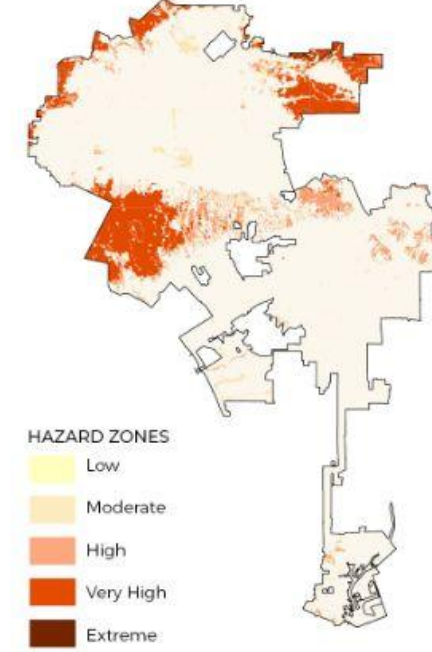

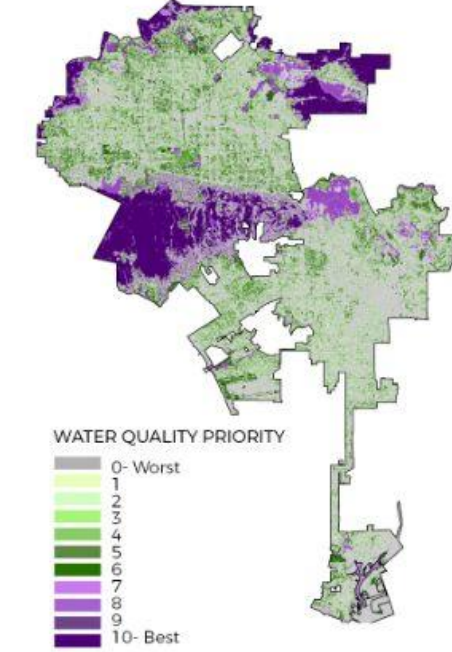

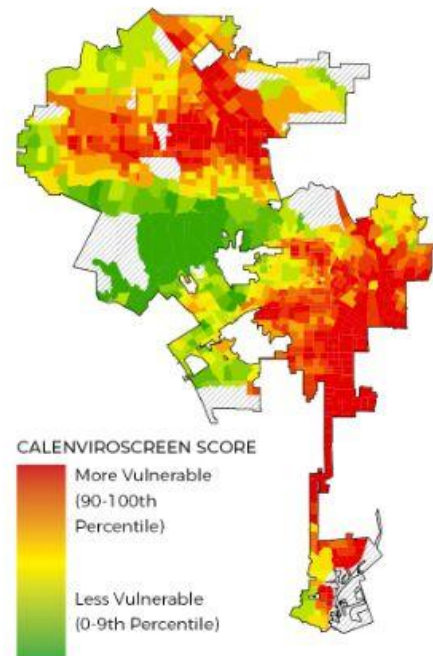

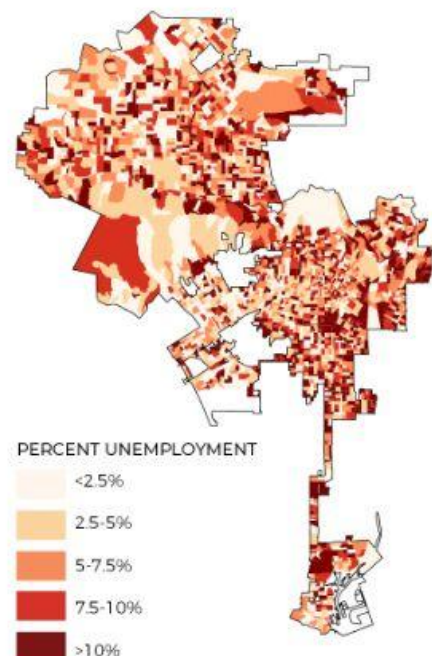

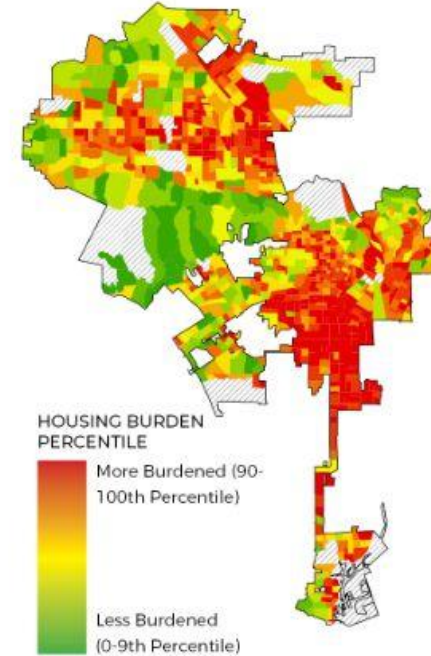

PERCENT UNEMPLOYMENT



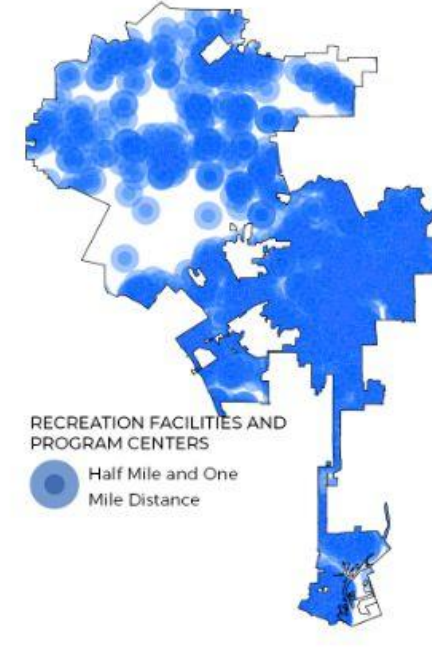

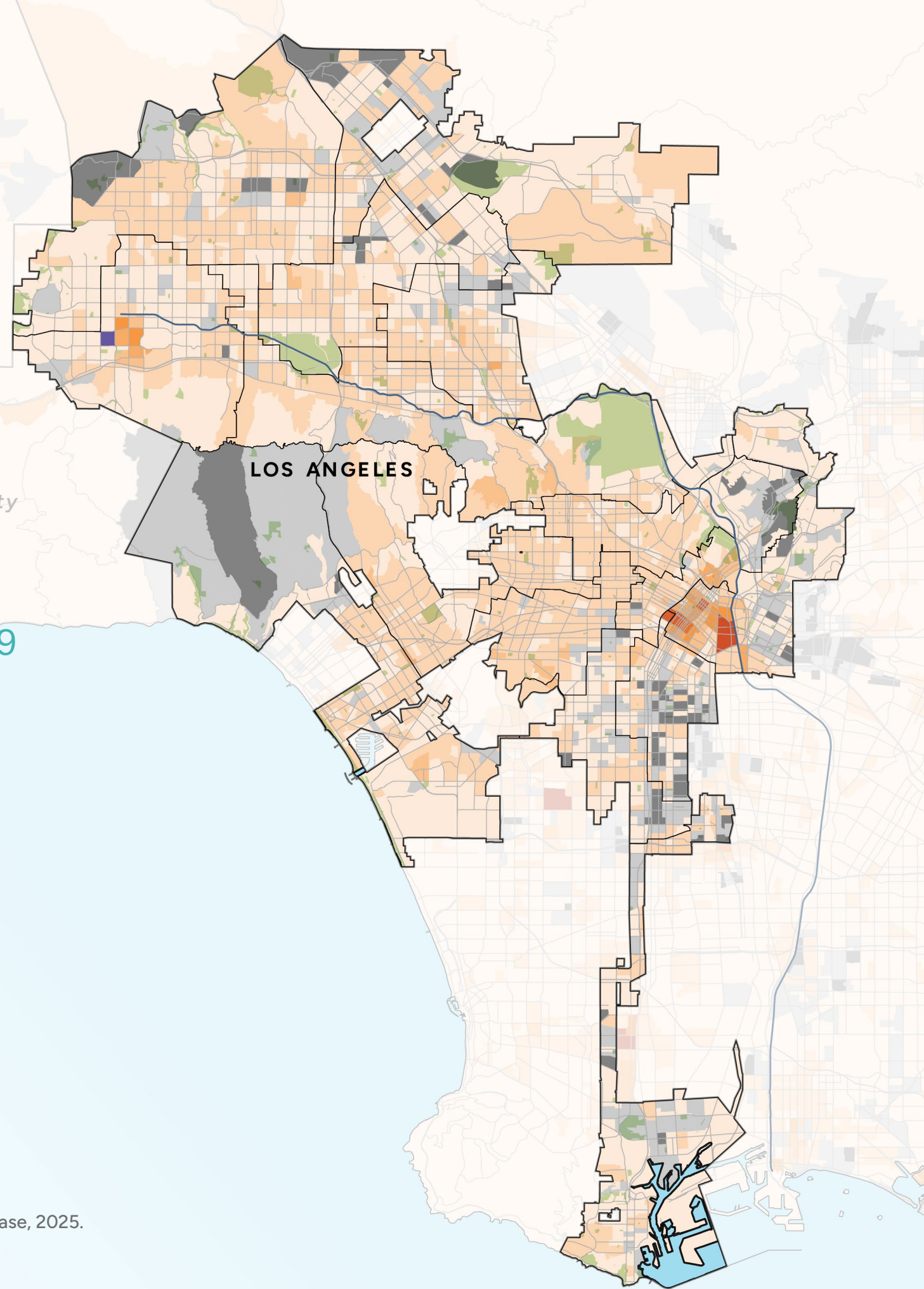

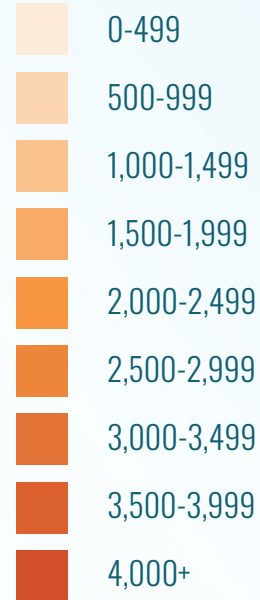
