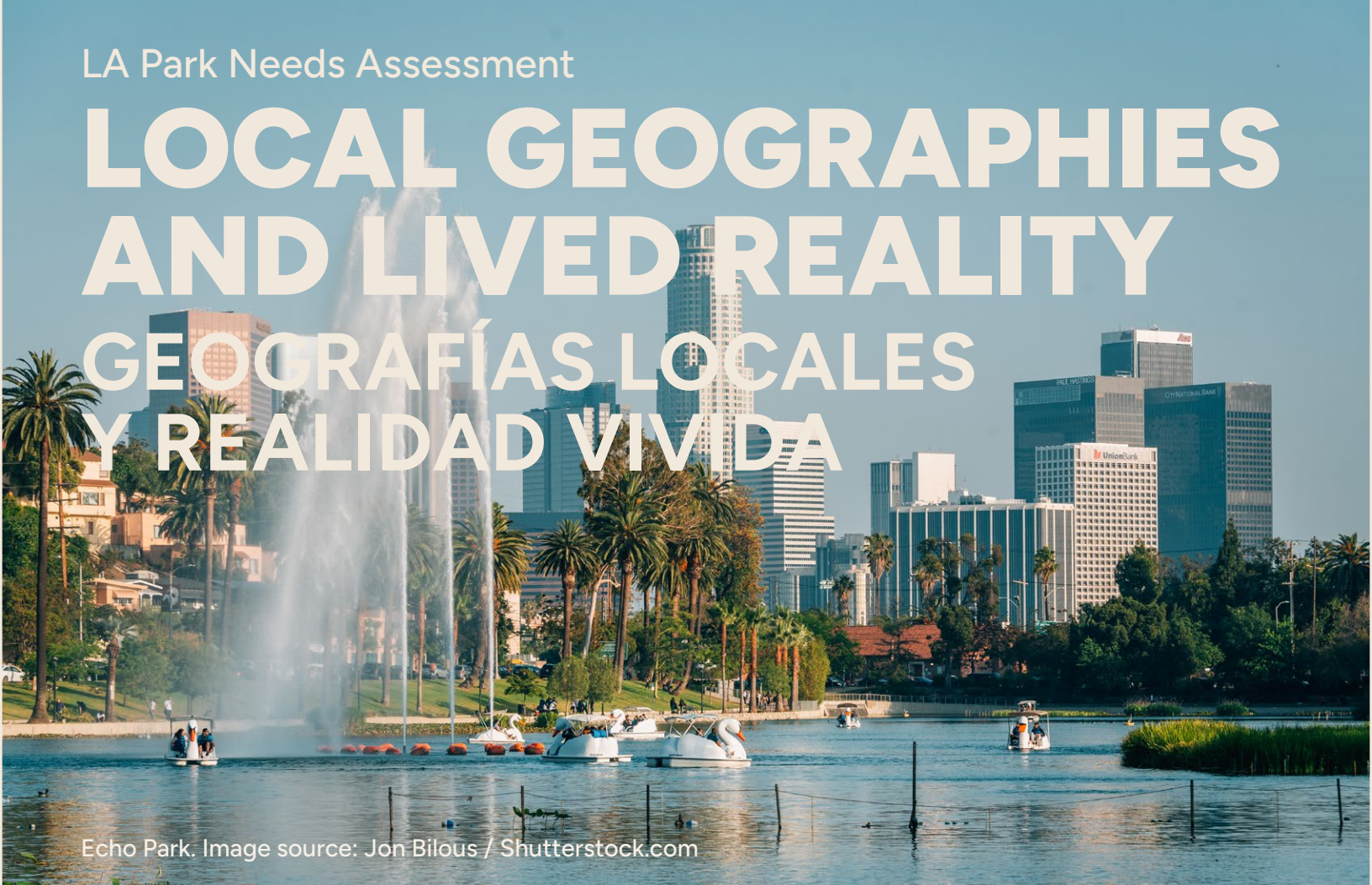

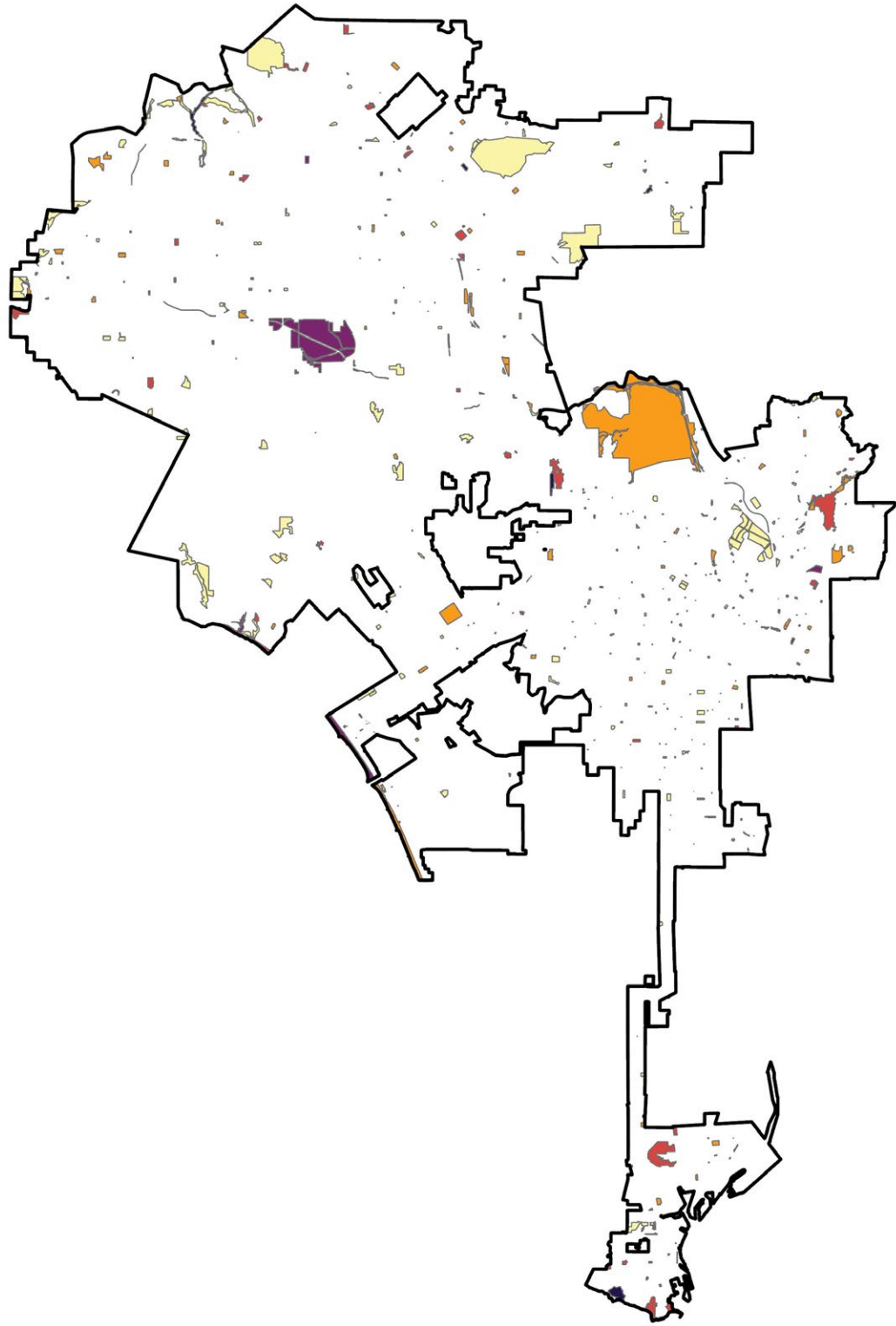

The City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) is conducting a Park Needs Assessment to evaluate and improve our parks and recreation facilities. This assessment will help our parks meet the needs of residents for decades to come, expanding spaces for enjoyment, exercise, and community connection.

WHAT IS A PARK NEEDS ASSESSMENT (PNA)?

A PNA is a process to determine City needs related to park infrastructure, and is useful for decision making around top priorities that are important to the community. A PNA incorporates community feedback and considers data about park locations and number of parks while future population projections and budgets to plan park improvements.

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

City continues to grow, it's important to understand the evolving needs of our community and provide safe, well-maintained, and accessible parks for everyone. This map will guide future planning and funding decisions, with the goal of having parks in all areas of the city.

HOW CAN YOU GET INVOLVED?

Public input is crucial and there are many ways you can be a part of this process. RAP is inviting the community to join engagement events, fill out surveys, and share their park ideas. Over 82 events or meetings will be held in 2025, inviting different neighborhoods, groups, and committees to participate.

Your input counts in shaping the future of our parks. Whether it's suggesting new park features, improving accessibility, or emphasizing that our parks are safe and inclusive for everyone, your feedback will directly influence future decisions about park development and investments.

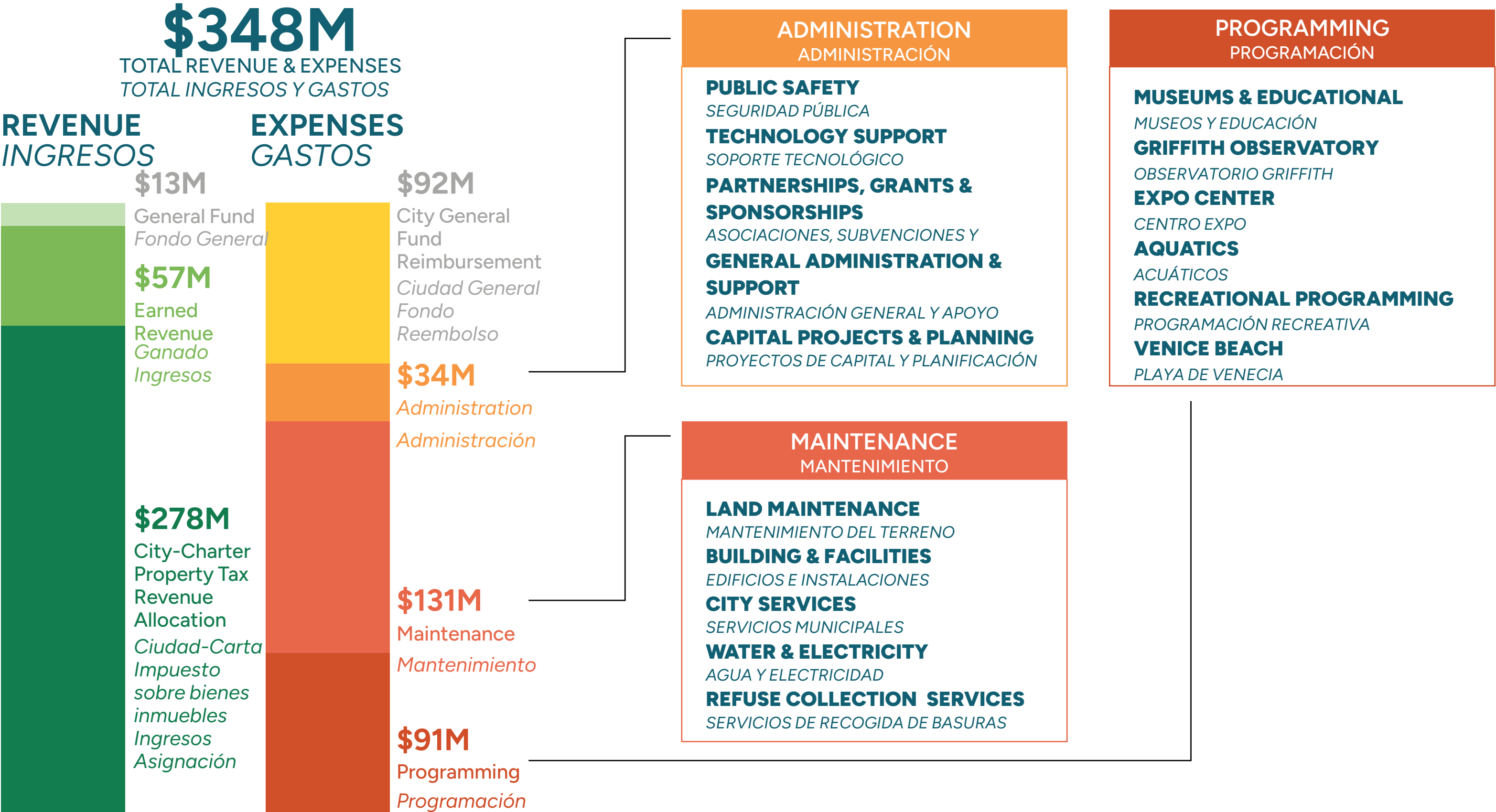

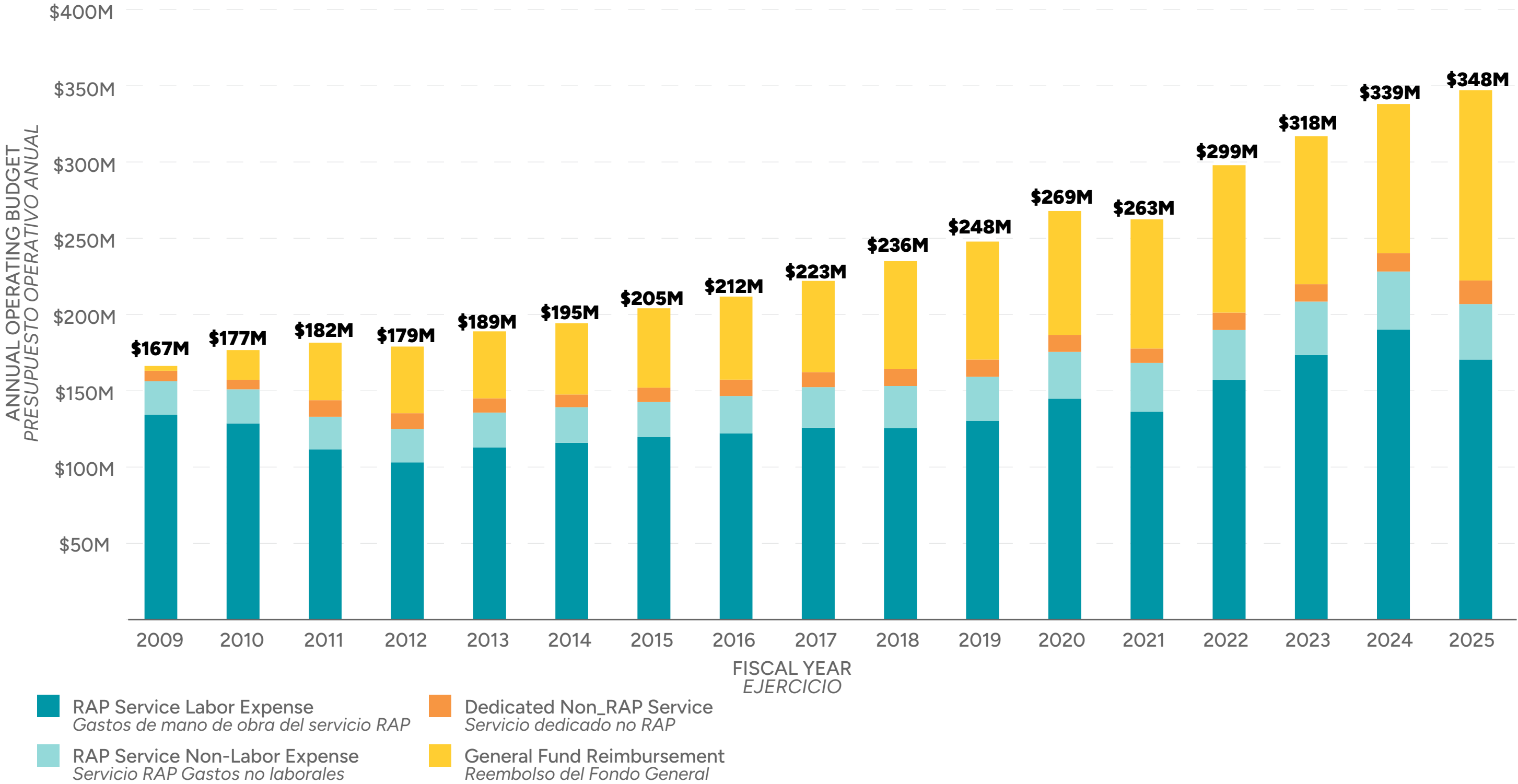

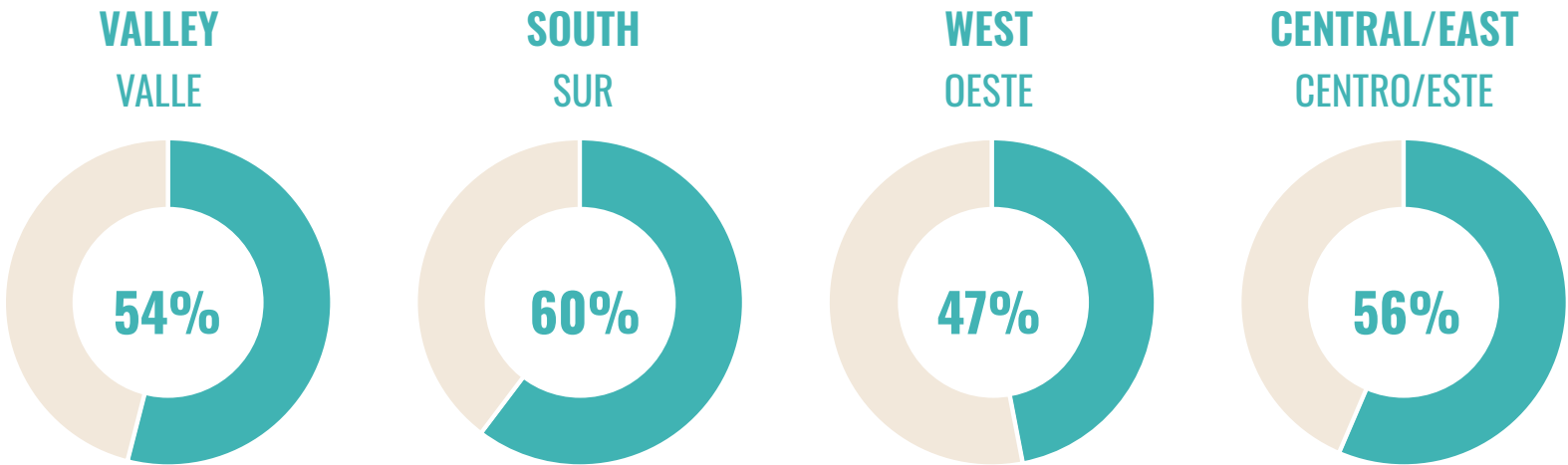

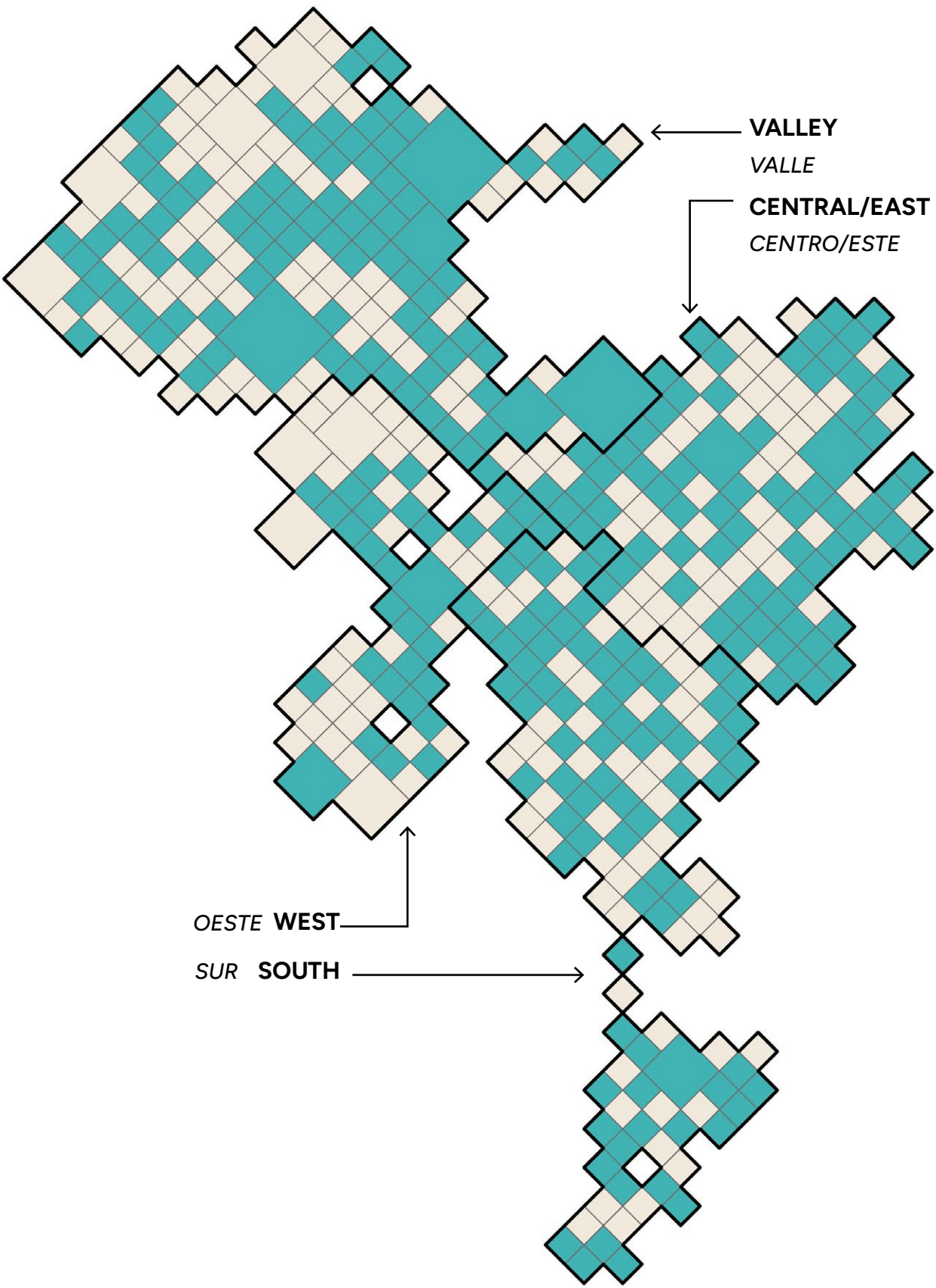

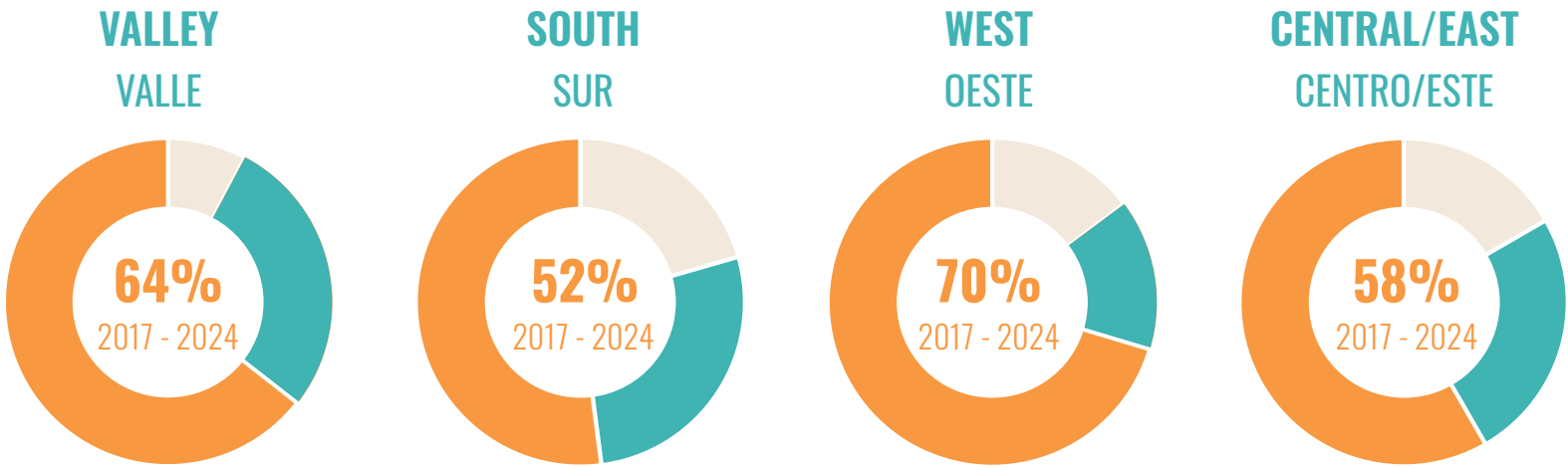

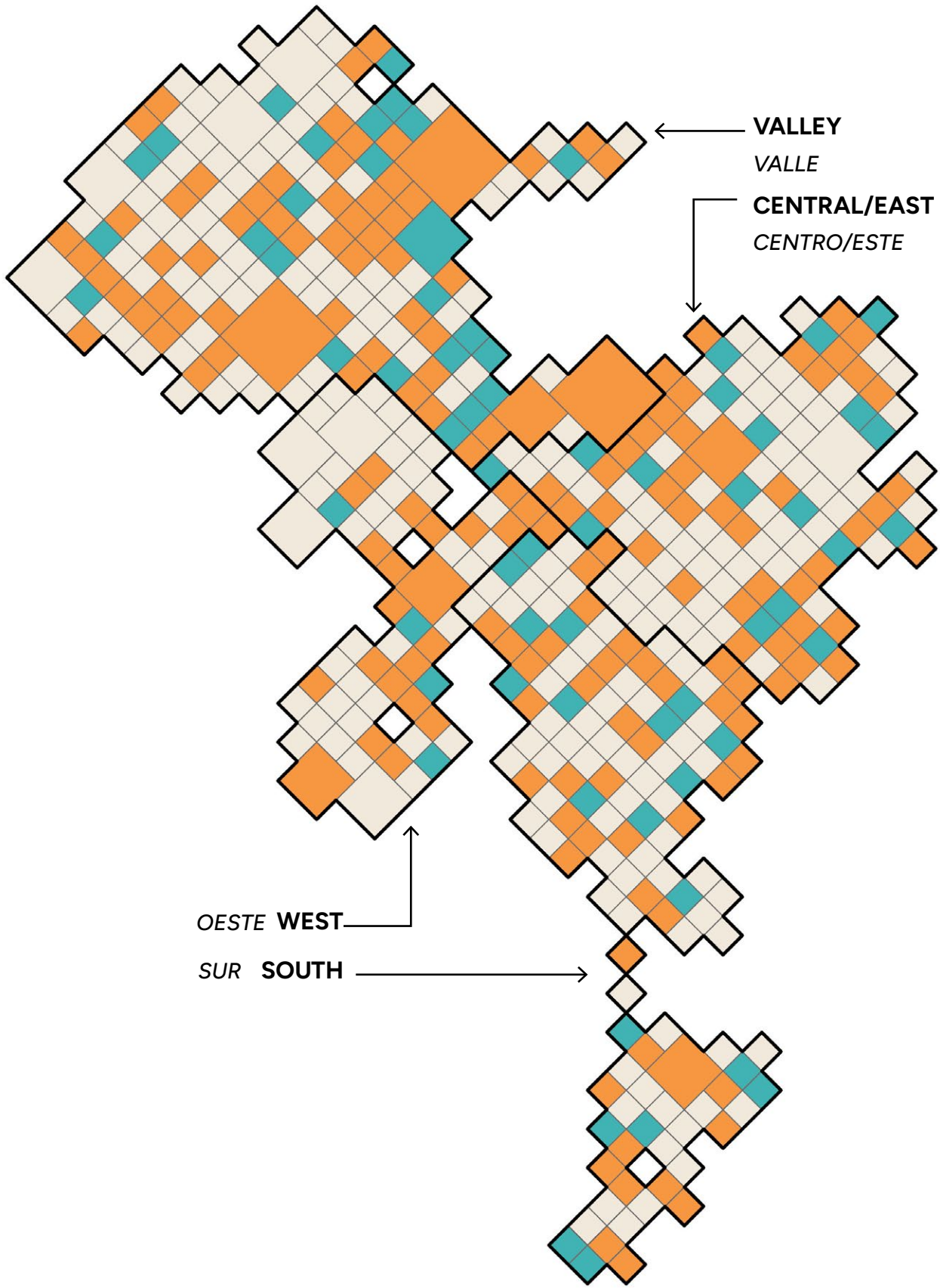


% OF PARKS WITH MOST RECENT INVESTMENT | % DE PARQUES CON INVERSIÓN MÁS RECIENTE
